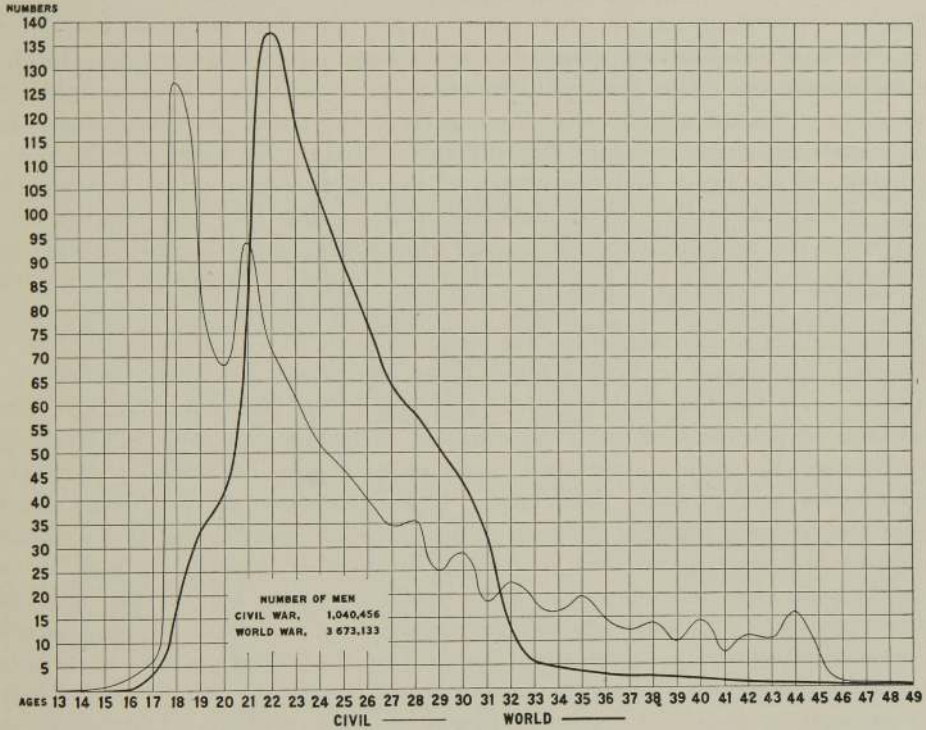


AGE DISTRIBUTION CIVIL WAR VOLS., AND WORLD WAR TROOPS, OFFICERS AND ENLISTED MEN

AVERAGE AGE, CIVIL AND WORLD WAR

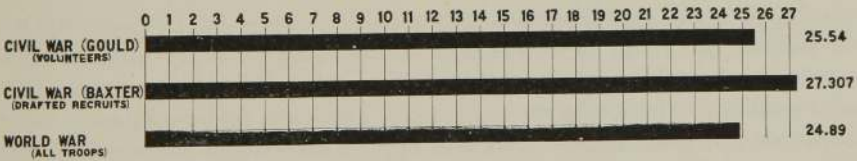
