

# C I R C U L A R !

SURGEONS and Assistant Surgeons and private Physicians in charge of hospitals in the interior of the State of Mississippi and Alabama, to which sick and wounded have been sent, are hereby directed to make reports weekly to the Medical Director of this army, giving the number of patients received in Hospitals, those reported for duty, recommended for discharge, or furloughed—in the two latter cases giving the full name, company and regiment. When soldiers are fit for duty they will be formed in squads under command of a non-commissioned officer, if there be one, if not, the Surgeon will designate some one to take charge of them, who will see that they are turned over to the commanding officer of the post to which they are destined. These instructions must be strictly complied with.
