**LETTER**

FROM

**THE SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY,**

*Transmitting statements of the manner and cost of providing for sick and disabled seamen, &c. &c.: of moneys received from Collectors of Customs, as also appropriations in aid thereof, with the annual expenditure on account of sick and disabled seamen, from 1802 to 1830, &c. &c.*

TREASURY DEPARTMENT,  
February 27, 1830.

SIR: In obedience to a resolution of the House of Representatives of the 1st instant, directing the Secretary of the Treasury to lay before the House statements:

First. Of the moneys collected under the acts for the relief of sick and disabled seamen, designating the amount received in each year, and for each collection district; and, also, if said moneys have not been collected in any district, the reason of such omission or neglect:

Second. The amount thereof which has been expended in each year, and in each district, "for the relief of sick and disabled seamen" in the civil service, and specifying the sums that may have been paid from this fund for other and what purposes; and also, the manner and cost of providing for sick seamen in the several ports; and also, what appropriations have been made, and when, for marine hospitals; and also, the amount remaining unexpended in the Treasury: I have the honor to transmit the accompanying statements, prepared by the Register of the Treasury. Statement marked A, exhibiting the amount of the moneys collected and expended under the "act for the relief of sick and disabled seamen," in each year, and for each collection district; statement B, exhibiting the amount of moneys received from the Collectors of the Customs, under the act of 16th July, 1798, as also of the appropriations made by law in aid thereof, with the annual expenditures on account of sick and disabled seamen, from 1st January, 1802, to the 31st December, 1828; and statement C, showing the manner and cost of providing for sick and disabled seamen in the several ports of the United States.

I have the honor, also, to transmit a communication from the Comptroller of the Treasury, in explanation of the cause of the omission to collect

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said moneys in districts bordering on the lakes, together with an instruction from the Secretary of the Treasury in 1805, requiring the same to be collected. No reasons are assigned for the exemption, nor are any to be found in the law. Instructions will be given for the collection of the tax in those districts as in all others.

As statement C, herewith transmitted, refers to the provision made for seamen at the several ports, during the year 1828, it may be proper to observe, that no material variation has since taken place in the arrangements then existing.

SIR: Having referred to me so much of the resolution of the House of Representatives of the 1st instant, as requires you, in case the marine hospital tax had not been collected in any district, to state the reason of such omission, an investigation of the subject has been made, from which it appears, that, in a letter, addressed by Mr. Secretary Gallatin to Collector Woolsey, under date of the 12th August, 1801, (a copy of which is enclosed,) he accorded in opinion with Mr. Wolcott, his predecessor in office, that the tax for the support of hospitals ought not to be exacted in the District of Champlain, (and of course not in any of the districts on the Lakes;) but no reason is assigned for that opinion.

From the enclosed certificate of the Register of the Treasury, it will be perceived, that, with the few exceptions mentioned therein, the tax has not been collected in those districts; and, that there have not been any disbursements made therein for the relief of any sick and disabled seamen.
