III. The appointment of officers of Army being vested by the constitution in the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, commanding and officers are hereby cautioned against assumption of this authority. All payments made to persons appointed as officers by military commanders, will be charged against the disbursing officers making such payments.

IV. General Hospitals will be under supervision and control of Medical Officers specially selected for the purpose, and announced as such in orders from this office. Medical Directors of Armed Army Corps and Departments will not interfere with this arrangement in respect

II. All recommendations from officers of the Army, for military appointments conferred, will, besides giving the name and qualifications of the person recommended, name the state which he was born, and of which he claims to be a citizen.
