*Exchange of Prisoners of War.*

The following prisoners of war, received and delivered at Rough and Ready, Georgia, the 19th, 22d, 28th and 30th days of September, 1864, in pursuance of an agreement between Major-General W. T. SHERMAN, U. S. Army, and General Hood, are declared duly exchanged:

United States prisoners received—

- 146 commissioned officers.
- 212 non-commissioned officers.
- 770 privates.

In all equivalent to 2,047 privates.

Confederate prisoners delivered—

- 128 commissioned officers.
- 225 non-commissioned officers.
- 979 privates.

In all equivalent to 2,045 privates.
