



PANSIES in abundance may be had by anybody who has ground available. Sow a packet of seed in a shallow box, in fine rich soil made smooth and rather firm by being pressed with a board. Sift a little fine earth over the seed, press with the board again, water gently with tepid water and place the box in a warm window. In three weeks the young plants will appear. A week later they may be transplanted, and soon be put out in the garden. If the season is too far advanced to raise from the seed, plants may be bought from the florists, which if put into rich soil, given plenty of room, light and water, will blossom till frost comes.






