Mr. GROSVENOR introduced the following bill:

A BILL

For a public building for a marine hospital at Gallipolis, Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby,
4 authorized and directed to purchase or otherwise procure a
5 suitable site, and cause to be erected thereon, at the city of
6 Gallipolis, Ohio, a suitable and commodious building for a
7 marine hospital; the plans and estimates for said building to
8 be prepared, examined, and approved as required by section
9 thirty-seven hundred and thirty-four of the Revised Statutes
10 of the United States, and at a cost which shall not exceed the
11 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars when finally completed:
12 *Provided,* That no money to be appropriated for said build-
13 ing shall be used until a valid title to the site selected shall be
14 vested in the United States, nor until the State of Ohio shall
15 have ceded jurisdiction over the same, for all purposes, during
